Whether you root for the Oakland A's, Seattle Mariners, San Francisco Giants, Medford Rogues, or another team, this month Ken Burns takes a look at arguably the most remarkable baseball player in the history of our great national pastime, Jack Roosevelt Robinson.

Looking at our increasingly diverse culture now, it is hard to imagine major league baseball had a color barrier. That all changed when Robinson stepped onto the field in 1947 at Ebbets Field in Brooklyn, becoming the first black player in the majors.

After his prodigious career in baseball, Robinson continued as a tireless advocate for civil rights as a newspaper columnist and a political activist. Martin Luther King, Jr. once said, "Jackie Robinson was a sit-inner before sit-ins, a freedom rider before freedom rides." You can see this special program on April 11 and 12 at 9 p.m.

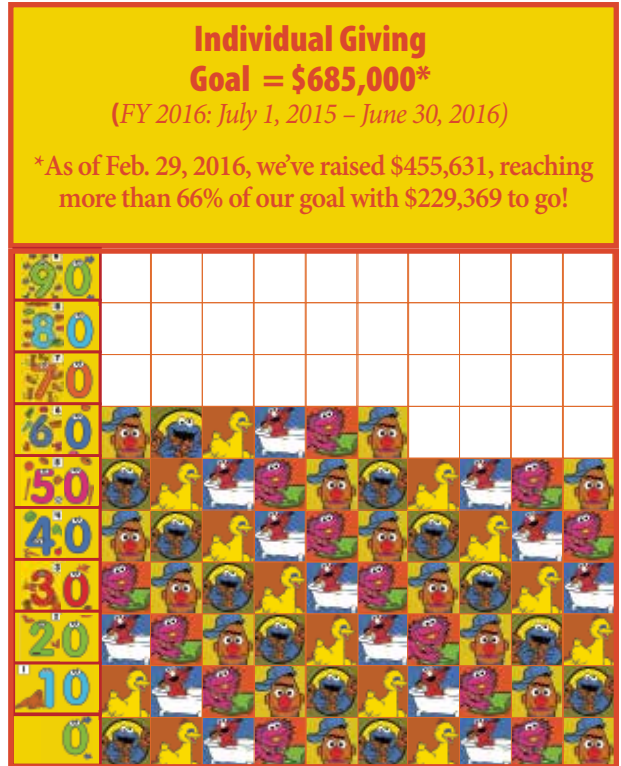
