



NEW LOCAL FOCUS ON VETERANS

This month our commitment to recognizing Veterans continues with another *Local Focus* special, this time reporting on the high

rates of veteran suicide. It is estimated that every 22 minutes a veteran commits suicide. Two recovering veterans, Doc King and Daniel Egbert, have produced a program for veterans, and they will discuss their film in our *Local Focus: Project 22* on Monday, February 8 at 9 p.m. with host Geoffrey Riley from Jefferson Public Radio. The next day, you can meet the filmmakers in person at a special preview — see the ad on the next page. On the following Monday, February 15 at 9 p.m., SOPTV will broadcast their film *Project 22*. In addition to the on-air broadcast on SOPTV, you can see *Local Focus: Project 22* on our video player at www.video.soptv.org.

NEW SERVICE FOR MEMBERS — SOPTV PASSPORT ON THE WAY

Speaking of access to programming online, PBS and a working group of stations have developed a new means for you to watch PBS programs for an extended period after their initial on-air broadcast. SOPTV will begin to roll out the new service called "Passport" over the next two months as a membership benefit for our sustaining members. Once we convert our membership system software by this summer, we'll be able to expand the service to all current members giving \$50 or more annually.

Of course, you can continue to record programs on SOPTV with your own equipment. Today nearly all programs broadcast are available for digital viewing, for free on SOPTV's website and hosted by PBS, and on the PBS channels on Roku, AppleTV, and other video-on-demand (VOD) services. The rare exceptions to extended viewing online are in situations where we do not have VOD rights. Look for more information about SOPTV Passport in the mail and in your e-mail.

POWER INTERRUPTIONS IMPACT KFTS OVER-THE-AIR SERVICE

Also I wanted to let you know we continue to have electrical failures with our Soda Mountain relay site, which sources our over-the-air services to the Klamath Basin. We are looking at new options to providing the service that will be more reliable.

IN MEMORY OF MARY JANE DELLENBACK

Finally, with sadness I want to the note the passing of Mary Jane Dellenback. Mary Jane was a member of the SOPTV Board from 2000–2006 and then rejoined in 2012 and served until her passing in December. Mary Jane was on the committee that hired me as SOPTV's CEO. I will miss her humor, clarity of thought, and candor. As noted in her obituary, Mary Jane asked those who knew her to remember her by doing something for someone else — from buying someone you don't know a cup of coffee, to contributing to a favorite charity. It was a privilege to know Mary Jane, and we will miss her.



Fats Domino: American Masters

Fats Domino was one of the most popular rockers of the 1950s and early '60s. His achievements and record sales during that time were rivaled only by Elvis Presley. With his boogie-woogie piano playing rooted in blues, rhythm & blues, and jazz, he became one of the inventors, along with Presley, Chuck Berry, Jerry Lee Lewis, and Little Richard of a revolutionary genre of music — rock 'n' roll. Domino suffered degradations in the pre-civil rights South and aided integration through his influential music.






