Members' Message

#### FISCAL YEAR WRAP-UP/SURVEY/FUNDING

**Program Costs.** Many thanks to those of you who have renewed your SOPTV membership or made an additional gift during our June fiscal year-end membership drive. Your support helps SOPTV bring you the programs you enjoy. We appreciate your support because we have recently received our bill for programming (\$413,686) for the new fiscal year beginning in July.

**Member Survey.** I hope you have participated in our 2017 Member Survey because your comments help us shape our services. This annual survey is one of the ways we evaluate our programming schedule, the local programs we produce, and your membership experience. We appreciate your feedback, so please use the survey form in May's *Inside SOPTV* or the online survey at <u>www.soptv.org/</u><u>survey</u>. We will be closing the survey on June 10.

**Federal Funding.** Over the last two months, many people have asked me about the status of federal support. Here's a summary: On Thursday, May 4, 2017, Congress passed the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 omnibus appropriations bill. The bill provides full funding for public broadcasting in FY 2017 (this year), including \$445 million for the Corporation for Public Broadcasting's (CPB) two-year advance funding for FY 2019. The bill also included \$50 million for the new program interconnection system (how SOPTV receives programming from PBS). The omnibus bill provides level funding of \$25.7 million nationally for Ready To Learn, our early childhood learning services. President Trump signed the bill into law on May 5th.

With FY 2017 funding finalized, Congress will now focus on the FY 2018 budget and appropriations process. For up-to-date information, please sign up for alerts at Protect My Public Media: <u>http://protectmypublicmedia.org</u>.

SOPTV's share of federal funding varies from year to year based on the funds we raise. Our federal funding is similar to matching funding. Our share ranges from 30–40% of our overall budget. Many small-market rural stations' percentage of federal funding can be 40% or more.

Overall, federal funding represents \$1.35 per taxpayer annually and is approximately 1/100th of 1% of the federal budget. The federal budget for 2017 is estimated to be \$4.2 trillion in expenditures.
