### Members' Message

### OVER-THE-AIR TELEVISION REALLY IS A MIRACLE...

Last December we had difficulties with a brand new translator we installed on Phoenix-Baldy Mountain in the Rogue Valley.

I am pleased to report the translator is now working fine. For those of you watching in the Klamath Basin, taking our signal from King Mountain or watching on Charter Cable, there was no interruption of service... and that may be all you want to know.

For other interested members, behind the scenes it was quite a time. You might have wondered why we changed channels. This activity was one of the last phases of the Federal Communications Commission's plan to "repack" television's digital broadcast spectrum into frequencies from channels 2 to 37. This move would provide additional capacity for wireless service providers to bid on available frequencies in an auction.

This caused some upheaval for Rogue Valley television broadcasters, as in some cases stations needed to move off frequencies. For example, SOPTV had to relinquish use of channel 42, which was awarded to SOPTV by the FCC to initiate digital broadcasting in 2002. Roughly 1,100 public and commercial stations were impacted.

About four years ago we anticipated ch. 42 would be at risk. Fortunately, SOPTV also had channel 34 on Phoenix-Baldy, which was being used as an analog service for viewers for years. So in 2015 we requested permission from the FCC to switch from ch. 42 to ch. 34 in advance of this event.

On July 30, 2018, we a received a formal notice from T-Mobile that they had acquired the right to use ch. 42, and we had until Nov. 30 to relinquish the frequency. T-Mobile graciously gave us a few extra days because ordering the new translator took additional time — particularly since so many stations around the country were ordering new translators.

On Dec. 11, we launched service with a brand new translator on ch. 34 at about 9 a.m. Then three brief hours later, the translator stopped transmitting! A part had failed, and we needed to ship the part back to the manufacturer in Illinois. With hundreds of stations awaiting translators, it took more than a week to get the part. Fortunately, our colleagues at DirecTV and Dish were able to reroute their receivers to take SOPTV's signal off our King Mountain site, which was unaffected because it broadcasts on ch. 8. Unfortunately, we were unable to get a signal to Ashland Home Network.

On Dec. 18, we returned to the air on ch. 34. After resolving a glitch that occurred from Dec. 29 to January 2, we have been providing service with a brand new translator atop Phoenix-Baldy Mountain.




