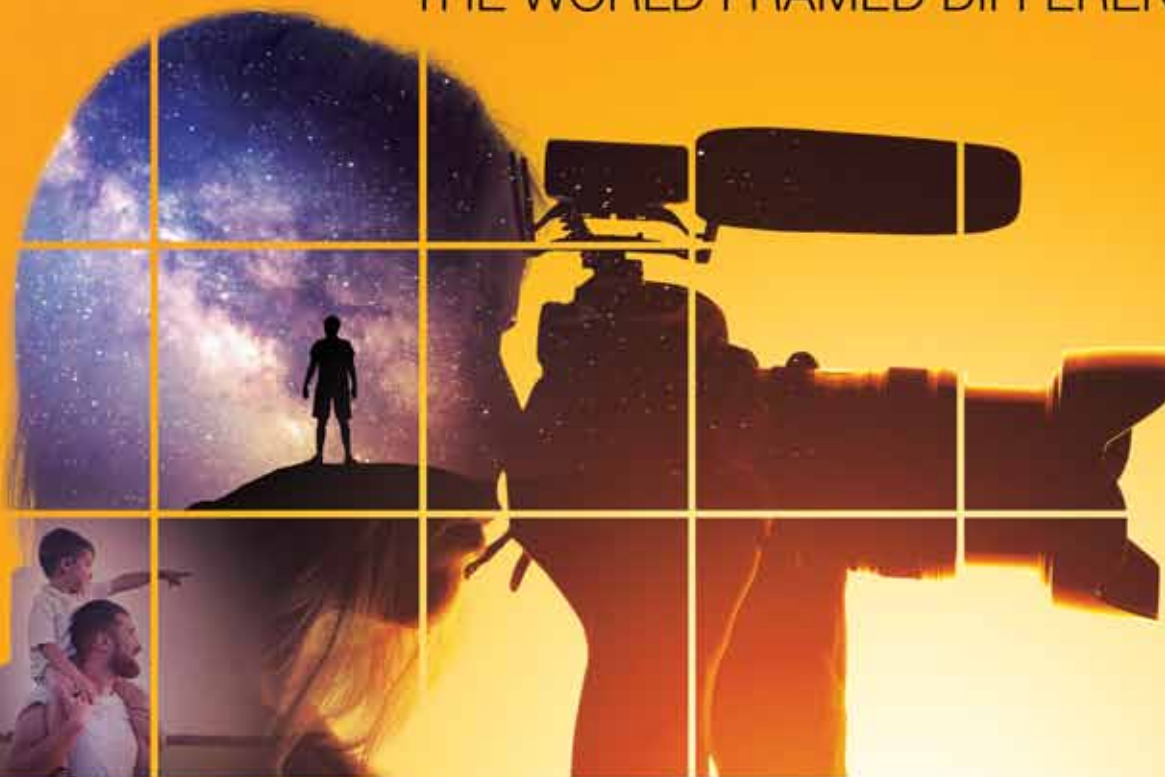

PBS Profile: Judy Woodruff

PBS journalist Judy Woodruff recently received the PBS Beacon Award, which recognizes individuals whose leadership, service and work inspire Americans and enrich our nation.

A renowned journalist who exemplifies excellence and integrity, *PBS NewsHour's* anchor and managing editor Judy Woodruff delivers insightful reporting on the issues that matter to Americans. Night after night, millions of people place their trust in Woodruff and the PBS NewsHour. She has spent more than two decades at PBS, and in 2013, she and the late Gwen Ifill were named the first two women to co-anchor a national news broadcast.

Woodruff is a founding co-chair of the International Women's Media Foundation, an organization dedicated to promoting and encouraging women in journalism and communication industries worldwide. She serves on the boards of trustee of the Freedom Forum, The Duke Endowment and the Carnegie Corporation of New York, and is a director of Public Radio International and the National Association to End Homelessness.

Along with the PBS Beacon Award, Woodruff is the recipient of the Radcliffe Medal, the Poynter Medal for Lifetime Achievement in Journalism, the Gwen Ifill Press Freedom Award and the Cronkite Award for Excellence in Journalism. She has also received the Edward R. Murrow Lifetime Achievement Award in Television, the Gaylord Prize for Excellence in Journalism and Mass Communication, and the Al Neuharth Award for Excellence in the Media. She was inducted into the Georgia Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame and received the Leonard Zeidenberg First Amendment Award, and the Duke Distinguished Alumni Award, among others. Woodruff is a graduate of Duke University, where she is a trustee emerita, and is the recipient of more than 25 honorary degrees.

Into The Classroom And Beyond



How SOPTV's Education Initiative Is Preparing Students For Careers in Media Arts

The SOPTV Teacher Community Program's (TCP) primary goal is to strengthen the career media arts pathway in Southern Oregon. Through strategic partnerships with local teachers and collaborative projects with local schools, from Kindergarten to Career, we work on behalf of aspiring digital and media arts professionals. We envision a Southern Oregon where high school graduates are equipped with the skills to successfully enter into college programs of study, and someday careers, that involve digital and media arts skills.

The foundation of SOPTV's TCP work started in 2018 with two teachers: video instructor Mike Mayben at North Medford High (NMHS), and leadership teacher Ivan Olinghouse at Hedrick Middle School (HMS). The initial goal was to provide students with industry-level contact and experience. We've been able to accomplish this in one short school year!

We are proud of the collaborative productions we've created with students. One shining example is a PSA the students created at the middle school level, which will help incoming

sixth graders feel welcome and safe at HMS. Another project is a student-led interview of SOPTV's President & CEO Mark Stanislawski, shot and edited by NMHS video students.

Next year we are going to offer an even better curriculum and a new national media partnership.

In addition, we have partnered with an SOU Digital Cinema professor, Chris Lucas, to write curriculum for video three and four students at NMHS. These lesson plans will align with introductory video classes at SOU and contain activities that reach industry standards.

SOPTV's Teacher Community Program has been accepted by **PBS NewsHour** to have two Student Reporting Labs (SRL) in the Medford School District. One SRL will be at HMS, and the other at a new partner high school, Central Medford High. Students will benefit from both industry-level curriculum and training!

If you haven't met me yet, my name is Ben Garcia and I coordinate the PBS Teacher Community Program at Southern Oregon Public Television.

As our station's "Teacher Ambassador", and also SOPTV's Education Coordinator, I am privileged to be able to go to WETA in Washington D.C. this summer

for a weeklong **PBS NewsHour** SRL training alongside local teacher, Ivan Olinghouse.

SOPTV Education will be covering traveling and conference expenses for Mr. Olinghouse, and we are proud to offer professional development like this to outstanding local teachers.

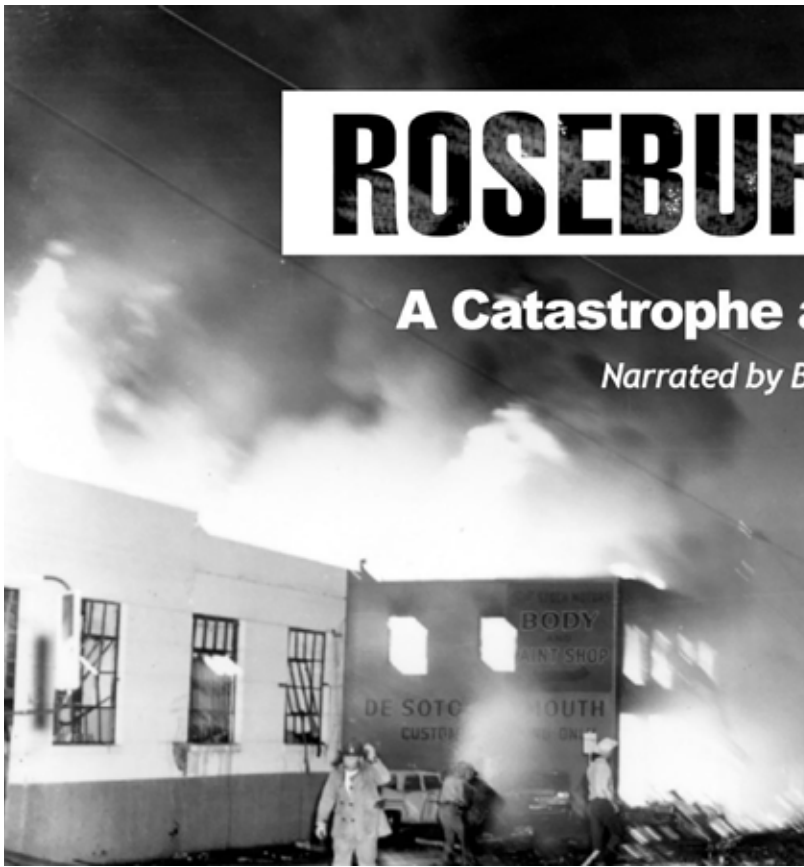

ROSEBURG BLAST

A Catastrophe and Its Heroes

AUGUST 7 at 6pm

Sixty-years ago, on a hot late night in August, a delivery truck, drives into the sleepy town of Roseburg and parks in the heart of the city awaiting the morning to complete its delivery of six-and-a-half tons of dynamite and blasting agent.

Early the next morning, at 1:14am, August 7, 1959, a small fire breaks out nearby.

Rescue workers, unaware of the truck and its dangerous cargo, rush to the scene, only to be among the first victims of a series of terrible explosions.

Before the night is over, 14 people are dead, 125 injured and everything within a 50-block radius of the explosive-packed truck is in ruins.

The next day, when the firestorm finally dies down, the catastrophe, which became known as “The Blast”, is national news with stories of ordinary people giving everything they had, sometimes even their lives, to save family, friends, and their hometown. A town that had been changed forever.

I think Woodstock continues to inspire because the grace demonstrated there was real and enduring."

One thing that hasn't wavered over time is people's fascination with and appreciation for photography. The process of mulling over age-tinged photos in battered photo albums or scrolling through photo galleries on our smart phones is exciting and fulfilling.

Family Pictures USA is a new travel-style television show that will focus on bringing people together to share family pictures and stories in a highly interactive and engaging experience known as Community Photo Sharing. The show will be a series of filmed CPS events with hosts and producers guiding participants through personal stories in which their collected photos serve as storytelling tools.

Family Pictures USA explores neighborhoods and cities through the lens of family photographs and the stories residing within them. The show travels to different locations within a given town or region and uncovers personal stories that connect people to a larger history and narrative of that locale. The show draws on local stories and photos to illuminate local connections between family members and communities to create an inclusive new Digital Family Album.

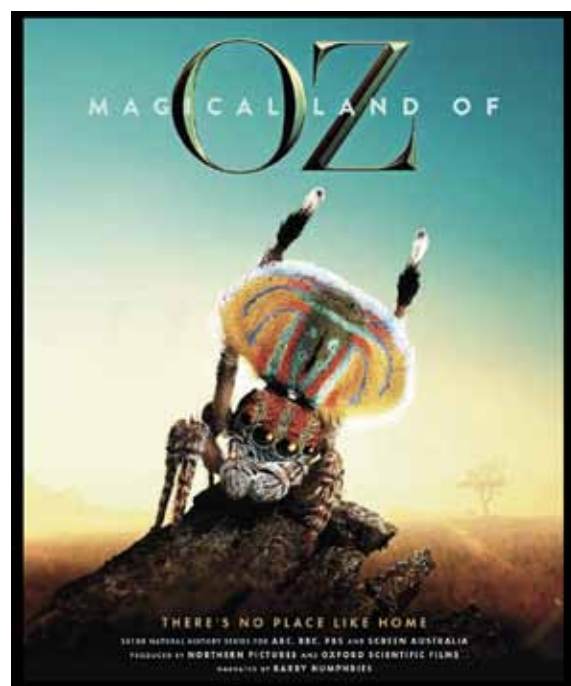
As our participants reconsider their hidden family photos, once stashed in boxes in dusty attics or on new smartphones, they unpack more than artifacts and ephemera. CHASING THE MOON

A FILM BY ROBERT STONE

Premieres Monday-Wednesday, July 8-10 at 9pm

Encores Tuesdays, July 16, 23 & 30 at 8pm

A new six-hour documentary series, *Chasing The Moon* is about the space race, from its earliest beginnings to the monumental achievement of the first lunar landing in 1969 and beyond. It thoroughly reimagines the race to the moon for a new generation, upending much of the conventional mythology surrounding the effort. The three-part series recasts the Space Age as a fascinating stew of scientific innovation, PR savvy, political calculation, media spectacle, and personal drama.

With no narration and using only archival footage, the film features new interviews with a diverse cast of characters who played key roles in these historic events. Among those included are astronauts Buzz Aldrin, Frank Borman and Bill Anders; Freeman Dyson, the renowned futurist and theoretical physicist; Sergei Khrushchev, the son of former Soviet premier

Nikita Khrushchev, who played a prominent role in the Soviet space program as a rocket engineer; Poppy Northcutt, the 25-year-old "mathematics whiz" who gained worldwide attention as the first woman to serve in the all-male bastion of NASA's Mission Control; and Ed Dwight, the Air Force pilot selected by the Kennedy administration to train as America's first black astronaut.

While other documentaries have largely painted a familiar narrative of goals set, obstacles overcome, disasters averted and missions accomplished, *Chasing the Moon* tells a vastly more entertaining and surprising story. As the film reveals, the drive to land a man on the moon was fueled as much by politics as it was by technology and was a controversial undertaking during a volatile time.

"When we think of that breathtaking moment of the 1969 moon landing, we forget what a turbulent time that was," said Mark Samels, AMERICAN EXPERIENCE executive producer. "The country was dealing with huge problems — Vietnam, poverty, civil rights — and there was a lot of skepticism about the space program. *Chasing the Moon* explores the unbelievably complex challenges that NASA was able to

overcome. Not a week goes by when someone doesn't say, 'Why can't we do something today as ambitious, as grand as putting a man on the moon?' It was a century-defining achievement, and our film tells a familiar story in an entirely new way."

"As a 10-year-old kid in England in July 1969, my mother woke me up in the middle of the night to watch two Americans set foot upon another world, the Moon quite literally staring at us through the window above our television set," said Oscar and Emmy Award-nominated filmmaker Robert Stone. "I'd recently seen Kubrick's '2001: A Space Odyssey' and the one-two punch of those two intensely visceral experiences ignited a fire in my mind that's stuck with me ever since. It's when I first began to want to be a filmmaker."

This broadcast will be accompanied by a multi-platform engagement campaign, including a series of screening events and discussions hosted by universities, museums and public television stations around the country, as well as an immersive, interactive website hosting original digital content that further explores themes and topics from the film.

JULY 8: *A Place Beyond the Sky* begins in 1957 and tracks the early years of the space race as the United States struggles to catch up with the Soviet Union. The episode reveals breathtaking failures and successes of the American space program and demonstrates the stakes and costs of reaching the moon.

JULY 9: *Earthrise* covers 1964-1968, four heady, dangerous years in the history of the space race, focusing on the events surrounding the Apollo 1 and Apollo 8 missions. As Americans moved through the 60s and reflect on the challenges ahead, many begin to wonder: What exactly is it going to take to beat the Soviets to the moon?

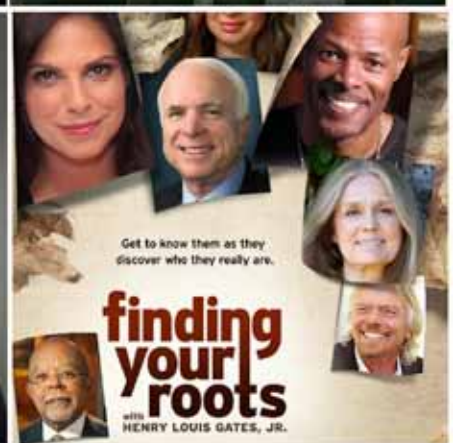
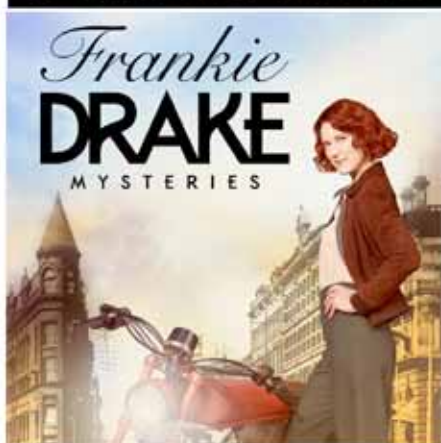
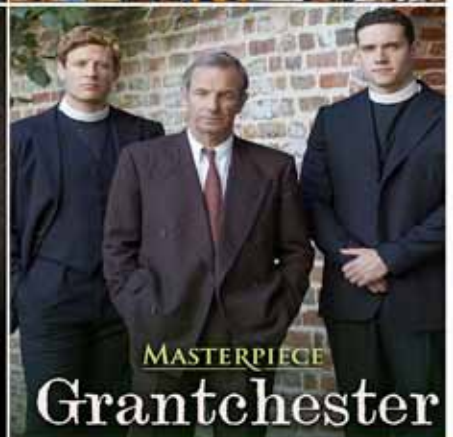
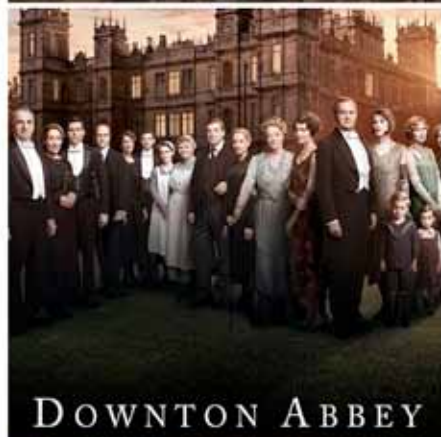
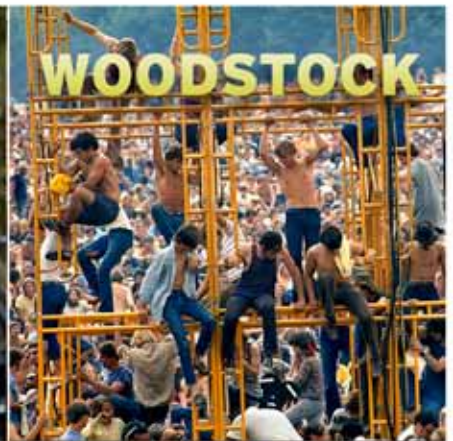
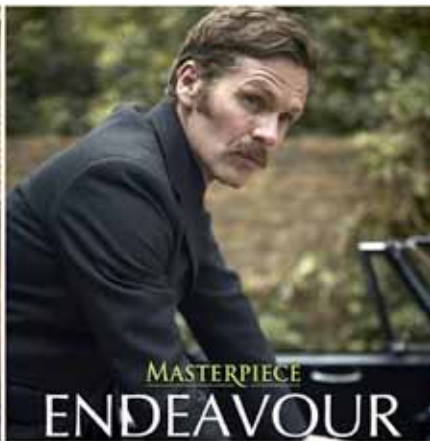
JULY 10: *Magnificent Desolation*, which covers 1969-1970, takes Americans to the moon and back. Dreams of space intersect with dreams of democracy on American soil, raising questions of national priorities and national identity. The final episode also considers what happens to scientific and engineering programs — and to a country — after ambitious national goals have been achieved.
