As you may have noticed over the past few years, SO PBS has an education manager. His name is Ben Garcia, and in one of his many roles, he coordinates the Southern Oregon PBS partnership with Medford and Eagle Point School Districts that is working to bring media industry experience for students at Hedrick Middle School, North Medford High School and Eagle Point High School.

These three participating schools will continue PBS NewsHour Student Reporting Labs classes as a year-long course where participating students will be trained in producing industry standard news stories. Working with Ben, teacher partners attended PBS NewsHour Training over the last two summers and have been certified by PBS Newshour to teach local students' industry standard video journalism skills in their SRL classes.

The PBS NewsHour Student Reporting Labs program is a national journalism initiative founded by the PBS NewsHour, and it is focused on connecting middle and high school students with public media stations to produce original, youth-driven news reports. Throughout the school year, Hedrick, NMHS and EPHS students

will use this opportunity to create short media stories and content that will then be submitted to PBS NewsHour and SO PBS for airing considerations in their nightly broadcast or on their website. If a student video is aired on the NewsHour's national broadcast, it could reach over one million viewers in just one night!

Ben's participation ensures student journalists are active in conversations about the critical issues facing our community and nation. In completing this program, students will not only gain industry-level experience and contact, but also national exposure. Every step of the production process will include mentorship from a PBS NewsHour veteran journalist.

Both Ben Garcia and Southern Oregon PBS take our roles as public media educators very seriously and we could not keep this aspect of our mission alive without your membership support.




ranklin, whose life has been celebrated as a quintessential American story, was anything but typical. His 84 years spanned nearly the entirety of the 18th century, an epoch of revolutionary change in science, technology, literature, politics and government—change that Franklin himself helped to advance. He launched the first public library in America, organized a volunteer fire company, and founded an academy that eventually became the University of Pennsylvania. His annual publication, "Poor Richard's Almanack," set a model for future humorists such as Mark Twain and contained maxims that are still part of our shared lexicon. And his famous experiments with electricity led to one of his most important inventions—the lightning rod.

While Franklin was committed to the ideals of the Enlightenment—always looking to improve himself, his community, and humanity at large—he was also full of contradictions. He could be whimsical yet philosophical, folksy yet unforgiving, generous yet shrewdly calculating, and broadminded yet deeply prejudiced. Critically, especially for a man so associated with independence and individual liberty, Franklin enslaved people and did not become an abolitionist until very late in life. The Franklin household had at least six enslaved individuals, including Peter, Jemima, Othello, George, John and King. Franklin's newspaper, The Pennsylvania Gazette, also advertised the sale of enslaved people and published notices of runaways. And while he publicly denounced white settlers who indiscriminately killed Indigenous people, he also championed the expansion of white settlements on to Indigenous lands.

"Benjamin Franklin was a fascinating and complicated individual who helped shape our contemporary world," said Ken Burns. "If we see him for more than his long list of accomplishments, we recognize an imperfect man challenging himself and his contemporaries as he tries to understand and improve the world around him. One of the best and most prolific writers of the 18th century, Franklin both embodies and documents the dynamic social, scientific and political changes of this revolutionary age. His story is one of hope, with a faith in the common man. But his shortcomings are also a reminder of this country's failure to address slavery at the time of its founding and the racial divisions that continue to impact our country today."

The actor Mandy Patinkin provides the voice of Franklin. Burns called the Patinkin's reading "distinctive and transcendent," noting that Patinkin's voice and timing seem to capture Franklin perfectly, finding just the right sense of humor and curiosity for life that Franklin presented in his many writings.







The show takes an up-close look at the conductor through intimate interviews with music experts including São Paulo Symphony Orchestra artistic director Arthur Nestrovski, Richmond City Orchestra music director Valentina Peleggi, wife Kristin Jurkscheit, members of Baltimore Symphony Orchestra and more.

What is consciousness? Is it in all living beings? Why are we predisposed for mystical experience? And what happens when we die?

What begins as a science film emerges far beyond the explicable. AWARE follows six brilliant researchers approaching consciousness, all from radically different perspectives: through Eastern meditation, with high-tech brain research, by methodically exploring inner space through psychedelic substances, and by investigating the consciousness of plants. Scientists are coming to new insights, some of which have been integral to Indigenous knowledge for millennia.

Christof Koch, a renowned neuroscientist and head of the Allen Institute for Brain Science, has come to openly question whether material science can find the origins of consciousness and has begun to ask if consciousness could be in all things, the fundamental essence of the universe.

Tibetan Buddhist monk Matthieu Ricard, himself a former molecular biologist, maintains we cannot approach consciousness from the outside, but only from the inside, through meditation.

Roland Griffiths, Director of the Center for Psychedelic and Consciousness Research at Johns-Hopkins University, is systematically investigating prohibited psychoactive substances used by Indigenous peoples for thousands of years to heighten awareness and cure illness. 'Psychonauts,' like modern day astronauts, are being trained and sent out to investigate and report back from their own inner space.

Philosophy professor Richard Boothby, previously an atheist, would not hesitate to say he encountered god during his psychedelic sessions.

Meanwhile, Biologist Monica Gagliano, professor at the University of Sydney, is making the empirical case in her lab that plants hear, see, communicate, learn, remember, and feel pain.

Mayan healer Josefa Kirvin Kulix posits that the "new science" seems to be coming around to resonate with an old worldview held by traditional, Indigenous people.

he plot thickens at an English seaside resort in the early 1800s, as MASTERPIECE continues its hit series expanding on Jane Austen's unfinished final novel. Rose Williams returns as the high-spirited heroine, Charlotte Heywood, with Crystal Clarke (as the independent West Indian heiress, Georgiana Lambe). Both are on the receiving end of multiple romantic proposals.

SISTERS RISING features six Native American women reclaiming personal & tribal sovereignty in the face of violence. Native American women are 2.5 times more likely to experience sexual assault than all other American women. One in three Native women report having been raped during her lifetime and 86% of the offenses are committed by non-Native men. These perpetrators exploit gaps in tribal jurisdictional authority and target Native women as 'safe victims.'

The film follows women who refuse to let this pattern of violence continue in the shadows: a tribal cop in the midst of the North Dakota oil boom, an attorney fighting to overturn restrictions on tribal sovereignty, an Indigenous women's self-defense instructor, grassroots advocates working to influence legislative change, and the author of the first anti-sex trafficking code to be introduced to a reservation's tribal court.
