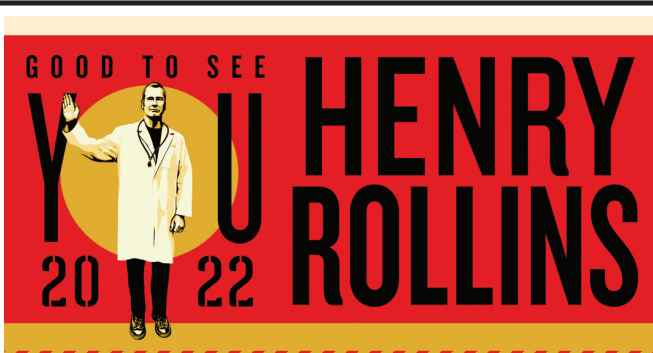

# SPRING PICKS

April showers have given way to May flowers and that means the first day of summer in June is not far behind. This edition of SPOTLIGHT reflects some great garden picks festooning in both months.

Highlights include the **ANTIQUES ROADSHOW** with three episodes from **COLONIAL WILLIAMSBURG** on May 9, 16 and 23 at 8pm. On Friday, May 27 at 9pm, **GREAT PERFORMANCES** premieres **KEEPING COMPANY WITH SONDHEIM**, a documentary exploring the legacy of Stephen Sondheim and George Furth's musical Company. Then, on May 29 at 8pm and 9:30pm, it's the **NATIONAL MEMORIAL DAY CONCERT**, with all new content and the return of acclaimed co-hosts Gary Sinise and Joe Mantegna, along with pops conductor Jack Everly of the National Symphony Orchestra.

SOPBS has also attractively arranged a bunch of PBS posies to enjoy in June. On Tuesday June 14 at 9pm, **AMERICAN MASTERS** premieres **BRIAN WILSON: LONG, PROMISED ROAD**. The Beach Boy's Brian Wilson takes us on an intimate journey through his legendary career as he reminisces with Rolling Stone editor and longtime friend, Jason Fine. This documentary features a new song written and performed by Wilson and interviews with Elton John, Bruce Springsteen, Nick Jonas, Linda Perry, Jim James, Gustavo Dudamel and Al Jardine.

On Sunday June 19, there are two great series premieres! At 8pm, it's **HOTEL PORTOFINO**, a new historical family drama set in the 1920s on the Italian Riviera. It revolves around the daughter of a wealthy industrialist who heads to Italy to set up a quintessentially British Hotel in the stunning town of Portofino. At 9pm, it's the premiere of **ENDEAVOUR ON MASTERPIECE** Season 8. Shaun Evans reprises his role for a new set of compelling cases. Episode One is entitled **STRIKER**.

On June 21 at 9pm, **THE MARK TWAIN PRIZE** is back with comedian, talk show host and political influencer, Jon Stewart, who has been named the 23rd recipient of the Kennedy Center's Mark Twain Award for lifetime achievement in comedy.

On Monday and Tuesday June 27 & 28 at 9pm, we will air **HIDING IN PLAIN SIGHT**, a Ken Burns presentation. This two-part series takes a look at the experiences of young people living with mental health conditions with a focus on the importance of awareness and compassion. This series will shine a light on what life looks like for these young people as well as for the parents, teachers, friends, and healthcare providers in their lives.

I hope you pick a great bouquet from these and many other great shows that will be blooming on SOPBS over the next two months.

Summer 1962: London is swinging with new music, hip fashions, and an irresistible hedonistic spirit. It's also seething with antisemitic violence incited by homegrown neo-Nazis.

RIDLEY ROAD is a riveting drama set in this colorful but tumultuous time, based on Jo Bloom's acclaimed novel and airing in four parts.

Politics is the last thing on Vivien's mind when she flees a proposed arranged marriage in Manchester to find Jack, whom her parents deplore. Little does she know that Jack has been recruited by the 62 Group in London as a mole to infiltrate the National Socialist Movement, a fascist party promoting violent antisemitism and racism.

Before she knows it, Vivien is also recruited—with the mission of finding out what has happened to Jack. She is far more successful than anyone dreamed possible, which pulls her deeper and deeper into a vicious lion's den of intrigue.

London is famous for its swinging era in the early sixties that launched a worldwide, youth-centered cultural revolution. Largely forgotten is the concurrent rise of extreme nationalist politics that seemed poised to take over the country.

## A FLOOD IN THE DESERT

**Tues, May 3 – 9pm**

The film tells the dramatic story of the March 1928 collapse of the St. Francis Dam and its aftermath, the second deadliest disaster in California history. The resulting flood killed over 400 people, destroyed millions of dollars of property, and washed away the reputation of one of the most celebrated men in Southern California, William Mulholland. A self-taught engineer, Mulholland had ensured Los Angeles' remarkable growth by building a cement aqueduct that piped water from the Owens Valley across the Mojave Desert and into the arid city, 233 miles away. But the bursting of his St. Francis Dam, the city's largest single reservoir, was a colossal engineering and human failure.



## PLAGUE AT THE GOLDEN GATE

**Tues, May 24 – 9pm**

Over 100 years before the deadly COVID-19 pandemic set off a nationwide wave of fear and anti-Asian sentiment, an outbreak of bubonic plague in San Francisco's Chinatown unleashed a similar crisis. The death of a Chinese immigrant in 1900 would have likely gone unnoticed if a sharp-eyed medical officer hadn't discovered a swollen black lymph node on his body — evidence of one of the world's most feared diseases, bubonic plague. When others started dying, health officials and business leaders were torn about how to stave off an epidemic without causing panic and derailing the city's booming economy. A fascinating medical mystery and timely examination of the tense relationship between the medical community, city powerbrokers and San Francisco's Chinese-American community, Plague at the Golden Gate tells the gripping story of the desperate race against time to save San Francisco and the nation from the deadly plague.

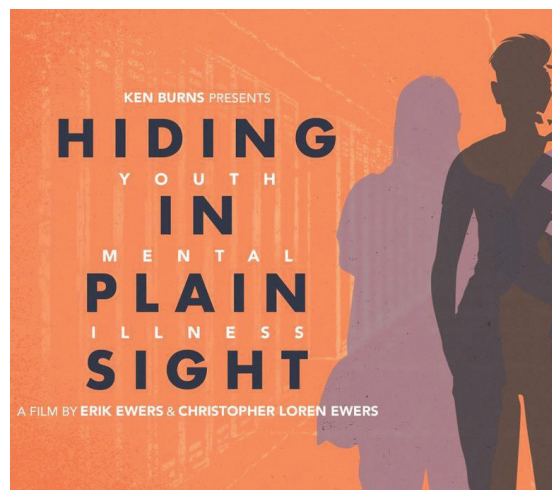

## In Two Parts, Mon & Tues, June 27 & 28 – 9pm

The two-part four hour film features first-person accounts from more than 20 young people, ranging in age from 11 to 27, who live with mental health conditions, as well as parents, teachers, friends, healthcare providers in their lives, and independent mental health experts.

The documentary presents an unvarnished window into daily life with mental health challenges, from seemingly insurmountable obstacles to stories of hope and resilience. Through the experiences of these young people, the film confronts the issues of stigma, discrimination, awareness, and silence, and, in doing so, help advance a shift in the public perception of mental health issues.

Mental illness is one of the most significant health crises in the world—as pervasive as cancer, diabetes, and heart disease—but it often exists in secret and is endured in isolation. It's the place where sadness leaves off, and depression begins; where nervousness becomes anxiety; excitement becomes mania, and habit becomes addiction. It's the place where simply living becomes painful.

It affects all ages, in families both rich and poor, healthy and dysfunctional. Trauma can be the trigger—from personal crises such as divorce and neglect to environmental disasters, racial injustice, and pandemics. Over time, the symptoms can progress, and lead to increasingly extreme behaviors—like eating disorders, self-harm, and thoughts of suicide.

The issues surrounding mental illness are extraordinarily complex. The risk factors are daunting, the economics bewildering, and the politics contentious. But the most important step—and often the most difficult one—is to start talking about it.

The aim of HIDING IN PLAIN SIGHT is that it will bring that conversation into homes, schools, the workplace, and community organizations across the country.

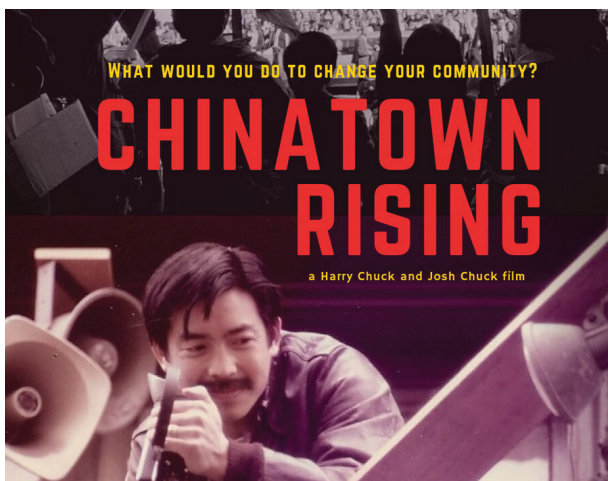
